Eagle Exploration Bus Tour

Travel by charter bus with an environmental educator to sites along the Hudson River for an in-depth tour of eagles in the region!

Begin the tour at Croton Point Park, visiting three eagle-viewing sites along the river to see eagles in their habitat. Reserve your spot in the 36-seat charter bus. Approximate length of the tour is 2 hours. Tour for adults and children 12 years of age and older. Tickets \$15.
